For one year, South Carolina residents can receive free credit monitoring and identity protection.

The state is paying for taxpayers to receive identity-protection services from Experian for one year. You can enroll online or by phone.

- Visit **www.protectmyid.com/scdor** and use the activation code **SCDOR123**.
- You will have to provide your:
 - 1) Name, Address, Phone Number, Birthdate
 - 2) Email
 - 3) Social Security Number
 - 4) Mother's Maiden Name
 - 5) You will create a login: Username and Password
 - 6) You will be asked to answer two security questions
- You will receive email or text notifications (no snail mail.)
