The Waccamaw Library is proud to announce that C. Hoppin Shuler is the artist of the month for November. Her works - many influenced by the beauty of the Lowcountry - will be on display throughout the library for the entire month.

Cynthia Hoppin Shuler has an extensive and impressive resumé of training and exhibition. Studying first in San Antonio, Texas, she won a competitive Fine Art scholarship at the University of Texas, Austin. She then completed her B.F.A. at Miami University in Ohio, with further post graduate studio experience at the University of Tennessee.

She has exhibited in one and two man shows in several states, and has competed in international, national and regional shows, winning acclaim and awards multiple times.

Her work shows a combination of impressionistic and expressionistic influences, with a rich pallet of joyous color. She delights in the range of subject matter available in the Low Country, and is particularly drawn to the figurative riches presented by the beaches of the Grand Strand.

Shuler is represented locally by The Island Fine Art Gallery in Pawleys Island and The Prince George Gallery in Georgetown.
