Maring is a retired circuit court judge who combines his legal experience with his military training and a strong southern biblical background to create spellbinding, can't-put-down suspense/thriller novels. His novels are often set in the Lowcountry, and run the gamut from historical fiction to murder and intrigue.

Maring will talk about his popular historical fiction, **Winyah Bay**. "The story of Winyah Bay is one that has lain hidden for many years," Maring says. "In my book, a recent archeological excavation finally uncovers its secrets. The story of the unforgettable people of the bay is revealed in a mixture of history, romance, and the triumph of the human spirit."

The book spans from prehistoric life with the Pre-Clovis people to the establishment of a doomed Spanish settlement and the arrival of the first British traders.
