**Library Offers Free Quicken 2014 Classes**

On Wednesday, November 5<sup>th</sup> at 10 a.m., Georgetown County Library is offering a free class in Quicken Premier 2014 that can set you on the right path with your personal finances.

“We taught Quicken workshops two years ago,” said class instructor George Leyendecker. “We had to increase the number of classes because the response was overwhelming. I think people appreciate that, with Quicken, a small commitment of time to track your spending and income pays off with a lot of information about your financial habits.”

With Quicken, you can see all your checking, savings, credit cards, loans, investments, and retirement accounts in one place.

“The program converts the numbers into easy to read charts, graphs, or reports” Leyendecker said. “Quicken also contains TurboTax categories that export to their tax software. Quicken will help you manage your investment or retirement portfolio. It even takes into account your age and lifestyle when tailoring a savings plan for you.”

The Quicken classes are paid for by a Smart Investing @ Your Library grant, and are held in the Georgetown Library Computer Area. You must sign up ahead of time, either by visiting the library or calling (843) 545-3300. Sessions are limited to 16 participants.

Attendees must have a computer running Windows XP, Vista or Windows 7 or 8 to use the software at home. Exact requirements are available at the library.
