Veteran's Job Fair March 9th

On the heels of a packed countywide job fair, the Georgetown County Library and SC Works Waccamaw are pulling out all the stops for the men and women who have served our country. The Veteran's Job Fair will be held on March 9th from 9 a.m. until noon at the Georgetown Library on Cleland Street.

"I hope every hero gets hired," said Library Director Dwight McInvaill. "Our general job fair in February had 18 businesses and 240 job seekers. We hope this event can be just as successful."

The job fair will feature dozens of hiring businesses, a "resume doctor," help with online job applications, and one-on-one interview practice. There will be information about continuing education and job assistance. Veteran's service groups will add information and entertainment to the morning. There will even be mini financial fitness tutorials, so you can manage the money you make at your new job.

"The library's purpose is to provide free, unbiased information and services," McInvaill said. "We're so happy to host job fairs, because we're a place people can trust. Job seekers know that the businesses and job search services at the event are the real deal, and never come with strings attached."
